2.1(A) COVID Guidelines and Masking Requirements – Craig Guensler

Letter from CDPH

Superintendent Guensler shared a brief presentation outlining the number of employees vaccinated at 131 and 89 who have not yet turned in proof of vaccination and will need to be tested weekly. He shared the District's Current COVID situation listed here:

WSD COVID Positives 2021-2022

- Staff
 - Classified School Employees Positive with COVID – 7 (6 out & 1 returned)
 - Certificated Employees Positive with COVID – 7 (4 out & 3 returned)
- Students @ BR campus
 - Current COVID Positives: 10 (8 out & 2 returned)
- Students @ WE campus:
 - Current COVID Positives: 12 (11 out, 8 were from this weekend & 1 returned)
- Students @ LT/WCA campus:
 - Current COVID Positives: 1 (1 out – from this weekend)

Superintendent Guensler continued with his new recommendation that all students and staff will be required to wear face coverings while indoors and on the busses when students are present, regardless of vaccination status.

Community Members, parents, grandparents and guardians shared their strong beliefs that children should not be forced to wear masks. The board members appreciated the passionate positions the parents expressed during tonight's meeting.
