

**Wheatland School District  
Board Insurance Increase to Cap  
2022/2023**

**Board Insurance Historical Data**

There was an agreement back in 2012 that when employees received an ongoing salary increase that the District would look at the Board Insurance Cap and discuss increasing it by a similar percentage. The District increased the Board Cap by \$122/month in July of 2014 based on the increases for staff. The Board increased the cap in 2021/2022 by \$83.33/month as the employees all received a 5% increase.

This year, 2022/2023, employees are receiving an 8% increase plus additional of \$1000 to \$2000 on the insurance cap (depending on the group). The Board continued to have the same Insurance Cap as the Superintendent which was increased by \$1000 on 10/20/22

This proposed increase to the Board Insurance cap is again tied to the substantial increase in both insurance cap and salary given to all employees for the 2022/23 school year.

**Proposal for 2022/2023**

To increase the Insurance Cap for the Board of Education by \$83.33/month which equals \$1000/year.
