2. REPORTS AND COMMUNICATION

2.1 Superintendent Update – Craig Guensler

- Superintendent Guensler started the reports and communications by requesting we move Action Item 5.5 after the Consent Agenda as the Chief needs to leave soon.
- He thanked the students in Mrs. Lamb’s Art class at Bear River for sharing their beautiful artwork.
- We are starting the bids for the cameras at Lone Tree.
- Summer Camp registration starts on April 23rd. Open enrollment is available for a 3 week period. Students must be current TK-8th grade students enrolled in Wheatland School District. Camp will not be available for Preschool or incoming TK-K students.
- Next year’s After School Program registration will open on May 23rd at 4:00 p.m.
- Wheatland Elementary’s Jog-a-thon will be held on May 23rd.
- The Reni Rallies for Lone Tree and Wheatland Elementary have been held and have had great attendance. Bear River’s are scheduled for tomorrow. The first is at 8:30 and the second will be at 1:00 p.m. Come early as parking could be an issue.

2.2 Enrollment Report

- There are 1368 students currently enrolled which is 34 more than this time last year, and 3 more than last month.
- We have 97 preschool students which is 3 more than last year and the same as last month.
- There are 1465 in all groups. Our Preschool numbers will like decrease significantly due to the age extension for TK students in the Fall.
