2. REPORTS AND COMMUNICATION

2.1 Superintendent Update – Craig Guensler

- Superintendent Guensler thanked the students at Bear River for sharing their beautiful artwork again.
- The Falcon Gardens Volunteer Day is scheduled for Saturday, April 26th from 8:00 a.m. to noon at Bear River. One of the sponsors will provide refreshments. Projects will include a concrete pathway and building student work areas.
- Summer Camp registration begins next week. There will be 2 sessions this year. June 9-27 and July 14-31. The hours of camp will be 8:00 to 5:00 and both sessions will be held on the Lone Tree School campus.
- After School Program sign ups begin promptly at 4:00 p.m. on Friday, May 23rd.
- Wheatland Elementary School's Jog-a-Thon will also be held on Friday, May 23rd.
- We will celebrate this year's retirees at the May Board Meeting.
- The enrollment at Wheatland Elementary and Bear River are completely full for next year and we may not be able to accept new Interdistrict Transfers. We may need to look at offering Lone Tree as an option for new requests for our impacted grade levels in town.
- The Educator of the Year Awards were held last Thursday and we were the only district to have all 5 board members there to celebrate the honorees. Robin Richardson received the Teacher of the Year; Megan Cunningham received the New Teacher of the Year and Ana Paredes is the Classified Employee of the Year for 2025.

There are 1376 students enrolled at the time of the agenda. That is 42 more students than last year at this time and 8 more than last month. We have 93 students in the preschool program which is 2 less than last year and 4 less than last month.
