Dear Parent:

We have found it necessary to suspend your student for violating these Education Code sections:

Ed Code Section	Violation
48900 (m)	Possessed an imitation firearm/replica of a firearm.

The incident that caused this suspension happened as follows:

At dismissal, while students exiting the campus, para-educator overheard students talking about a gun in this student's backpack. Para-ed was escorting 1st grade student to ASP who also heard the students discussing the gun. Para-ed followed the group to after school program on campus, notifying the school office administrative assistants who notified the ASP Director who checked this child's backpack and located the imitation gun. The gun is plastic, does not have an orange tip or any toy-like markings and appears by visual to be a valid firearm. It was not loaded. By all accounts from teacher interview and para-ed interview (who heard the students), this child did not brandish or make threats, however, at least one peer told his mother (as confirmed by mother contacting admin) that he saw this child's gun in his backpack. Admin was notified of the weapon. Admin made contact to superintendent, parent. Security Forces, the parents of students who were reported to have been present that the para-ed could identify. Student is suspended until such time as an expulsion hearing takes place with the Wheatland School District Board. This suspension form indicates a 5 day suspension, however, student is not to return to school until the expulsion hearing is complete and, at that time, a determination of student's status at school will be determined. Parents will be notified of the expulsion hearing date.

Your student has been suspended for 5 days. This makes a total of 5 this year.

The first day of suspension is 10/30/2025. The first day back at school will be 11/6/2025


The incident that caused this suspension happened as follows:

During this suspension, the student is expected to remain at home under adult supervision and may not attend school activities or be on or around the school campus. Students may be allowed to make up the work missed during the suspension at the discretion of the teacher, as provided in the education code. My signature also indicates that I have been informed that it is a violation of the terms of my suspension to loiter on public streets without adult supervision during regular school hours (7:30 am to 2:30 pm). I understand that failure to abide by these rules is a violation of law which can be punished by arrest and/or incarceration in the County Juvenile Hall or other appropriate law enforcement facility (California Penal Code, Sections 626.2, 626.4, and 653-g). These prohibitions will remain in effect until the Wheatland Elementary School District permits my return to a school within the District.
