We have found it necessary to suspend your student for violating these Education Code sections:
 48900.2


Ed Code Section	Violation
48900 (m)	Possessed an imitation firearm/replica of a firearm.

The incident that caused this suspension happened as follows:
 Billy had an air soft gun in his backpack that resembled a real weapon. He was hiding it for a friend who was being searched. Billy will be suspended for 5 days pending possible expulsion.

Your student has been suspended for 5 days. This makes a total of 5 this year.
 The first day of suspension is 10/29/2025. The first day back at school will be 11/5/2025.

At an informal conference, your student was advised as to the reasons for this disciplinary action and was afforded an opportunity to present a response. During this suspension, the student is expected to remain at home under adult supervision and may not attend school activities or be on or around the school campus. Students may be allowed to make up the work missed during the suspension at the discretion of the teacher, as provided in the education code.
